

Camp Tekakwitha - Fee Schedule

Use of Camp Tekakwitha is subject to the Camp Rules

Tent (Primitive) Camping

\$1.50 per person for one or two nights. Count all adults, youth and children

Group camping is available to most church youth groups and groups affiliated with a recognized national youth organization such as the BSA. Tekakwitha does not supply equipment. If you have more than 40 campers you may need to rent additional portable toilets.

★We are not setup for family camping

Swimming Pool

Cost for the use of the pool is \$30 per hour. An approved lifeguard and adult supervision must be present any time a group is using the pool. If you have more than 40 swimmer you will need to provide additional lifeguards. You may bring your own guard(s) but they must be approved by camp management at least 14 business days prior to camp use. If you use our guards, the minimum charge is \$20/guard/hour (Payable directly to the guards). Call us at 205-838-8301

Keiser Lodge (Lodge)

The usual fee for use of Keiser Lodge is \$250 per day. 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Extended hours are possible but must be arranged in advance

Bunk House Accommodations

Usual rental day is from 3:00 PM to 1:00 PM the next day (negotiable)

Housing – The minimum charge for each bunk house is \$150 per night which includes up to 15 campers (adult and/or youth). Additional campers are \$10 per person per night in the same bunk house. Neither food nor beverages are permitted in any of the six bunk houses. Each bunk house is intended to house either all female or all male participants. We do not have co-ed or family housing available.

★Bathroom facilities within a bunk house are limited to those staying in the bunk house.

Schwarzhoff Hall and Kitchen

- \$200/Day – The regular charge. Usual period is 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 - No Charge - If you rent at least one bunk house for a minimum of two nights (for diocesan organizations only)
 - \$150 per day – If you rent at least one bunk house for one night (for diocesan organizations only)
- **St. Kateri Chapel - No Charge**
 - St. Kateri Chapel's primary function is as a place of Catholic Worship. The chapel is available only for approved religious functions. It is not to be used as a meeting room. Catholic groups planning to use the chapel for Mass must provide a priest. The camp is **not** available for weddings (indoor or outdoor)
- **Deposit & Fees**
 - A minimum \$100 non-refundable non-transferable deposit is required to hold your reservation
 - A minimum \$200 refundable damage deposit is required
 - Fees are due in full at least ten business days in advance of your reservation at which time all fees are non-refundable
