Swimming Pool

Cost for the use of the pool is \$30 per hour. An approved lifeguard and adult supervision must be present and “on deck” any time a group is using the pool. If you have more than 40 swimmers you will need to provide additional lifeguards. You may bring your own guard(s) but they must be approved by camp management at least 14 business days prior to camp use. If you use our guards, the minimum charge is \$20/guard/hour (Payable directly to the guards). Call us at 205-838-8301

Rivers Pavilion (Maximum Capacity is approximately 100)

Cost for using Rivers Pavilion is \$250 per day. The Pavilion is available only to groups who are staying in bunk houses. Newly opened in 2021, Rivers Pavilion is a large space (60' x 60') with tables, chairs, small stage, simple sound system, projector, and screen. Sound system and projector use must be arranged prior to your group's arrival at camp.

Bunk Houses (Each Bunk House Has Maximum Capacity of approximately 20 persons)

Usual rental day is from 3:00 PM to 1:00 PM the next day (negotiable)

Housing –The basic charge for each bunk house use is \$15 per person per night. Neither food nor beverages are permitted in any of the 6 bunk houses. Each bunk house is intended to house either all female or all male participants. We do not have co-ed or family housing available.

Bunk houses will be assigned to your group by camp management. Please make any special requests when you make your initial reservation.

★Bathroom facilities within a bunk house are limited to those staying in the bunk house.

Schwarzhoff Hall and Kitchen (Maximum Hall Capacity is approximately 40 persons)

* \$200/Day – The regular charge. Usual period is 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM (discounts possible). If you have more than 40 participants, you must arrange to use Rivers Pavilion.

St. Kateri Chapel - No Charge but Must be Reserved (Maximum Capacity is about 60 person)

St. Kateri Chapel's primary function is as a place of Catholic Worship. The chapel is available only for approved religious functions. It is not to be used as a meeting room. Catholic groups planning to use the chapel for Mass must provide a priest. The camp is not available for weddings (indoor or outdoor)

How to Plan an Overnight Event with more than 40 participants at Camp Tekakwitha

Plan to reserve spaces in bunk houses for your participants. Use Rivers Pavilion for all meetings and indoor activities, including Mass. Use the Kitchen at Schwarzhoff Hall to prepare meals (bring your own cooks, food, and paper goods). Package meals in portion-controlled servings using boxes, lunch bags or foam clamshells. Transport meals from the kitchen to the Pavilion. Packages are laid out on tables for participants to pick up. Plan to use St. Kateri Chapel for private devotions while observing capacity limits. Other ways to make use of Camp Tekakwitha are possible, please consult with camp management early and we will help you plan the perfect event.

Deposit & Payment

- A minimum \$100 non-refundable non-transferable deposit is required to hold your reservation
- An additional non-refundable deposits may be required
- Fees are due in full at least ten business days in advance of your reservation at which time all fees are non-refundable
